15 Potential Areas for Process Improvement

- 1 Activities that fix errors instead of preventing them
- ² Unnecessary handoffs or complex communications between roles or other processes
- ³ Unclear decisions or conditions
- 4 Educate your PMO and project sponsor. Getting an understanding and training for ALL involved is key to buy-in and defining success criteria of an agile methodology
- 5 Inefficient flow of existing process
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 - Opportunity for parallel versus sequential work
 - D Order of existing sequence
 - Loops that can be eliminated
- 6 Activities that are being performed by an inappropriate resource
- Authority ambiguity (2 or more people making the same decision)
- ⁸ Areas that have too much or too little management control
- Poles that are bottlenecks
- 10 Activities that have unclear role assignment
- 1 Areas with backlogged work
- Areas with activities that do not provide business value
- 13 Areas that produce waste
- Areas that produce defects
- 15 Areas that cause frustration
